Course Pathways

There are two pathways students can follow when studying at Fakenham Sixth Form. The pathways below indicate the typical entry requirements on each pathway, however, these may be altered based on a student's circumstances.

Pathway A: A Level (Level 3)

Students who achieve 5 or more 4-9 grades will complete 3 A Levels and an EPQ over two years. Alongside these students will also attend registration, Future Skills lessons and Enrichment.

Pathway B: Access pathway (Level 2/3)

Students who achieve GCSE grades 2s or 3s will study one of the 'Access Pathways'.

Access A-Level/T-Level course

This pathway B programme is designed to support students' progression onto Level 3 study. Students who achieve GCSE grades 2s or 3s will study the Level 2 Programme including GCSE English and Maths Resit, Higher Project Qualification, careers meetings, registration, Future Skills lessons, and Enrichment.

To prepare students for A Levels they will complete AQA unit awards in the subjects they wish to study at Level 3. Students will also complete two days of Work Experience in a self-selected placement, every week.

Access to work/Apprenticeships

This pathway B programe is designed to support student progression onto work and apprenticeships. Students who achieve GCSE grades 2s or 3s will study the Level 2 Programme including GCSE English and Maths Resit, Higher Project Qualification, careers meetings, registration, Future Skills lessons and Enrichment. To prepare students for work or apprenticeships they will complete AQA unit awards for work skills. Students will also complete two days of Work Experience in a self-selected placement, every week.

Sixth Form Life and Personal Development

At Fakenham Sixth Form we believe that sixth form life is not only about academic success but also about developing the skills and attributes needed to be happy and successful in society. Our personal development programme is delivered in a variety of fun and exciting ways to encourage students to develop confidence and resilience. See below.

Future Skills

Future Skills lessons are scheduled twice a fortnight. Lessons are designed to support students' personal development and prepare them for living independently, in the wider world. Our three core themes of 'health and wellbeing', 'relationships' and 'living in the wider world' ensure students prepare for adulthood.





Enrichment Programme

An important part of Sixth Form life is taking part in enrichment activities which widen experience, cultural knowledge and horizons. We have a variety of sessions to choose from such as debating, Amnesty International, self-defence, magic moments and medical ethics to name a few. The activities and opportunities vary slightly from year to year.

Leadership Opportunities - Sixth Form Student Council

The Sixth Form Student Council representatives are elected by students at the end of the Autumn term. The council represents the Sixth Form at promotional events and provides a voice for the students in the running of the Sixth Form. Council members organise social events which contribute to the friendly ethos of the Sixth Form.

We believe that educational visits help support wellbeing and the students' academic progress. Trips are normally organised within departments or as a whole year group. Some of the more recent trips include Cambridge Cultural day, Bramley Lakes, Iceland, Auschwitz and UCAS events. The Drama Team have organised several Theatre trips to see a variety of productions including Everybody's Talking About Jamie and The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Nighttime. At Fakenham Sixth Form we believe it is really important to celebrate success. Recently we have rewarded students by taking the whole sixth form to the cinema to watch a Christmas film, an Easter egg hunt and a summer barbecue.

Work Experience

All Year 12 students are required to complete a two-week work experience placement in July. This provides important opportunities for students to learn and practise new skills, increase their confidence and enable them to find out if their chosen career is for them. Work experience also provides valuable content for UCAS applications and CVs, making individuals more desirable to universities and employers.

Volunteering

Ambition Group

As part of our commitment to supporting students to meet their goals, we run Ambition Group. In the group we look at the requirements needed for a place at the Oxbridge colleges, how to advance using super curricular activities and how to excel during the application process for Oxbridge and Russell Group universities. All students are welcome to attend this informal group.

Assemblies & Guest Speakers

We have a wide range of visiting speakers who address local and national issues. Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

The Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) is an independent research task and involves students either writing an extended essay of 5,000 words or creating a product with an accompanying shorter essay of 1,000 words. It is a great qualification to take alongside three A Levels / BTECs. The EPQ allows students to extend their abilities beyond the A-level syllabus and prepare for university, apprenticeships, or their future career. It is worth half an A-level so can be used to earn extra UCAS points for university or simply to allow students to study a topic of their choice.

Norfolk Higher Aspirations Programme The Norfolk Higher Aspirations Scheme is a fantastic resource that supports students' academic achievement. They run virtual and face to face subjectspecific sessions and support applications to university and apprenticeships. The Higher Aspiration Scheme gives students the best tools to make competitive applications to universities of their choice such as Oxbridge and Russell Group universities. There are a wide range of events and trips that all students in the Sixth Form are encouraged to take part in.







Careers

At Fakenham Sixth Form students are given lots of support and guidance when thinking about their post-18 destinations. We do this through 1:1 careers meetings, visiting universities, guest speakers from a wide range of employment sectors and online tutorials on our careers platform, Unifrog. We know that good careers advice is vital for students to make the right decisions about their future.

Thursday 21st August 2025


Enrolment takes place on GCSE results day on Thursday 21st August 2025, at Fakenham Sixth Form. Students will receive information about enrolment on Induction Day.


Why did I choose Fakenham Sixth Form? I chose Fakenham sixth

Why did I choose Fakenham Sixth Form? I already knew most of




