### **Autumn Reports**

All students have received their Autumn report. This included Minimum Expected Grades (MEGs) for each subject and current working grades based on class assessments. We will be working with students to ensure they meet their MEGs in all of their subjects. This will include students having conversations with their teachers, form tutors and, where necessary, parents being invited in to discuss progress with the Sixth Form Team. ### **Home Study Applications**

Students can apply for home study in which they can pick three sessions a fortnight, when they have no timetabled sessions, when they can go offsite. Students will need to meet the following criteria to achieve authorisation.

- Have good attendance (95% or higher)
- Working hard inside and outside of lessons.
- On target to meet their Minimum Expected Grades (this is defined as being one grade below the MEG or higher).

### **Good Study Habits**

All Sixth Form students have made study timetables to ensure they use their time wisely and have been a copy of the timetable to bring home to share with you. The number of hours spent studying is directly correlated to their academic outcomes. We have encouraged students to add some relaxation time and hobbies to their plans to ensure they have a balance of academic and non-academic activities. ### Attendance

Attendance is the key to success therefore we wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of good attendance. Students are expected to attend all timetabled sessions, this includes Registration, Enrichment and Future Skills alongside their subjects to support students' academic and personal development. If a member of staff is absent, due to illness or training, students will be set work on ClassCharts and where possible a cover teacher will be in with the class. If there is no cover teacher, students must go to S07, the Study Room, to register and complete the work set, so we have an accurate record of attendance.
