Dear Parent / Carer

We are nearing the halfway point of the public exams and the students in Year 11 have been a credit to themselves, the school and you as parents and carers – their hard work and effort will pay off in their results this summer.

### **Pre-exam revision sessions**

Each student has received their exam timetable including the venue they are taking each exam in. Please make sure they have this and that you are aware of when and where their exams are.

Before each exam we will be holding pre-exam revision sessions. This is a short session where teachers will go over the final few reminders to help students do well in their exam – it is vital that all Year 11 students attend these. These sessions will start at 8.40am and run until 9.10am. At this point, the students will have 10 minutes to have a snack and compose themselves for the exams. There will also be revision sessions for the afternoon's exams during period 3.

### **Equipment**

I will take this opportunity to remind students that they should attend their exams with all the required equipment including pen, pencil, ruler and, if appropriate for the exam, a calculator.

### **Lessons during the exam period**

All lessons continue to run as normal during the exam period. Teachers have planned structured revision in lessons to ensure that students are as prepared as they can be – attendance at these lessons is more important than ever. Study leave has not been granted to students for many years now, so all students are expected in school every day as normal.

### **Leaving Events**

**Leavers Assembly.** This is always a good occasion where we say well done and good luck to the Year 11 students, whilst reflecting on how far they have come in the last 5 years. This year due to exams, this event will take place on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June during period 3 after the last Physics exam. The assembly will be a celebration of the students' time at school during which we will do the draw to find out who has won the Passport to Success prizes – the main one being a laptop computer.

Students will also be allowed to sign shirts (I recommend bringing a spare shirt to sign) and books on this day as well as collecting their leavers hoodies if they have bought one. Students will be allowed to leave the school site from 12.20pm, if your child needs to stay in school for the afternoon, please let us know.

Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June is also the final day that students are expected to attend lessons. **Please note that students taking Spanish have an exam after this date (16<sup>th</sup> June). Students must attend in uniform for all exams.**

## Leavers Prom

This year's Leavers' Prom will take place at Fakenham Racecourse - Prince of Wales Stand on Thursday 25th June. Arrivals are from 6:00pm and there will be space for parents and others to come and watch the students arrive. We will finish by 10.30pm.

There are several things that would help us in the organisation and running of this event. You may be able to contribute prizes which we could raffle off. Or perhaps you can contribute items for the Prom itself, for example decorations. You might like to contribute financially. If you or your business would like to contribute in some way to the additional activities at the prom or donate some other forms of support, then please do get in touch.

All money raised will go towards the Leavers' prom, if there should be any funds remaining after the event this will carry over to the next year for similar activities.
