SEND pupils - Our SEND Team will be contacting SENDCOs at our feeder primary schools during the summer term to review the needs of pupils transferring to us to ensure their needs are met and the necessary support is on hand from their first day with us. We will also be arranging extra transition activities for any pupils that may benefit from this, we will be discussing this with the relevant staff at your child's primary school.

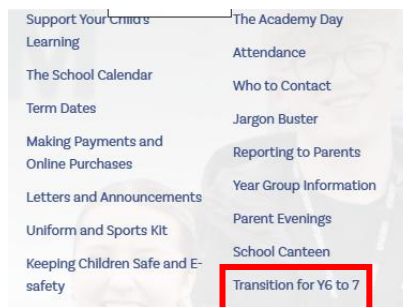
**Step 1:** Go to
